# We are making healthcare more accessible and reducing health inequalities

### Extended Access Hubs

Providing weekend and out-of-hours appointments across the City including in some of our most deprived communities.

### Mental Health Transformation

Transforming services by breaking down traditional barriers between primary and secondary care, in addition to addressing gaps in existing service provision.

### Inclusion Health Champion

Improving the quality of services provided to homeless people and asylum seekers, as part of her overall role reducing health inequalities across the city.

# We are improving the quality of care

### Clinical Assessment Support and Education Service

Referrals to secondary care are GP peer reviewed with advice and guidance offered to referring GPs.

### Providing at-scale primary care services

Over 70,000 appointments were provided at-scale last year, Improving access to primary care services whilst freeing up practice time.

### Training and development for practices

Our training arm, Primary Training Solutions provides a programme of accredited training for GPs and practice staff.

### Care Coordinators

Working closely with patients and bringing together all of the different agencies needed to deliver a bespoke care plan.

### RESTORE2

Providing award-winning training that gives carers the skills they need to work more closely and effectively with health care services.
